

The HexBox is a treasured possession in any home, and with good care, it can last for generations.

HexBox would provide entertainment like never seen before. It is designed to be interactive and build competitive bonds between friends and family.

CARING FOR YOUR HEXBOX

Avoid heat and light. HexBox is made of wood. In a natural state, wood contains a surprising amount of moisture. Preserving appropriate moisture levels is key to the preservation of furniture. Accordingly, position HexBox away from heating vents, fireplaces or radiators. Don't store Hexbox unwrapped in attics, where temperature and humidity levels vary widely from summer to winter, day and night.

Avoid HexBox placing in areas where it will sit in direct sunlight, which can fade its design. Use drapes, sheers or protective window films to guard against the sun's rays. Protect from damage. Everyday life can be hard on a wood board. Moisture from sweating beverage glasses leaves round rings in the finish. While the heat from a hot dish can ruin the wood finish beneath. Do not set cork- or felt-bottomed coasters, glasses or mugs on HexBox; and in event of spill, clean safely with dry clean towel. Dust frequently.

Avoid food or liquid residue on HexBox as dried stains would leave marks on the board that would affect the game. When there's a soil, Microfiber cloths do a good job of attracting and removing fine blown-in soil. Avoid using a feather duster, as a broken quill can scratch and damage delicate finishes.

Dusting with a dry hard cloth can scratch, so use soft cloth or gently moist your cleaning cloth with water, a spray dusting agent or wood polish. Never spray HexBox directly, as over-spray can leave a difficult-to-remove film. Frequent dusting removes dirt before it has a chance to settle in and make itself at home.

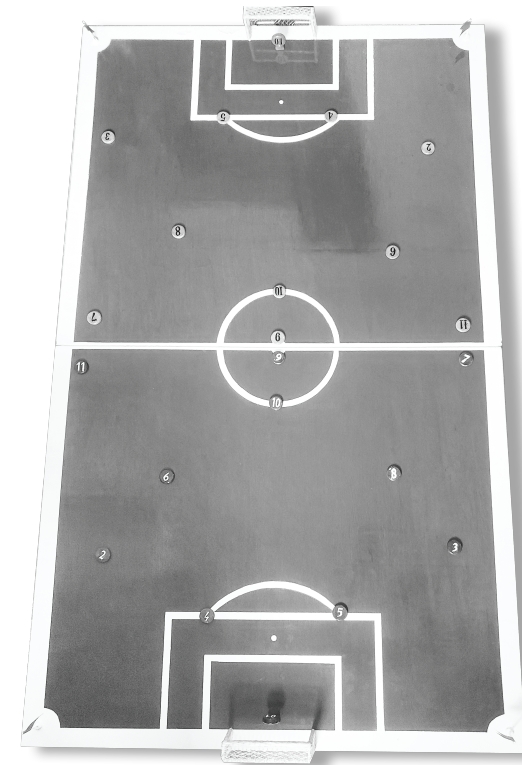

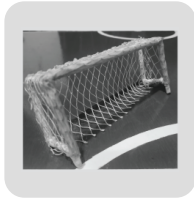

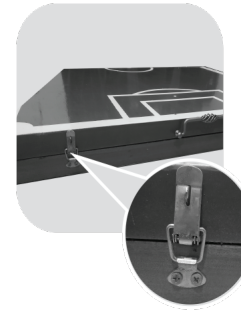
(A)	Game board	(E)	Corner flag

- NB: Play on flat surface only

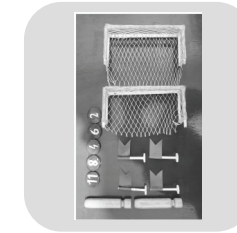
ASSEMBLY & PLAYING INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1



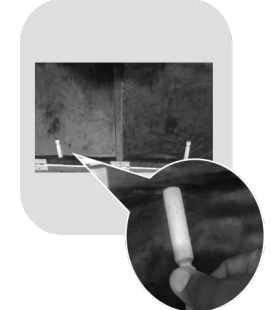
Open locks

STEP 2



Set aside all components

STEP 3



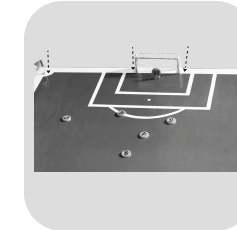
Turn the board upside down and insert plugs (G) into the holes in the middle of the board. Make sure it is fully and evenly inserted, and the board is firmly held together. When removing, remove with caution and avoid damaging the plug.
NB: Game can be played without the plugs also.

STEP 4



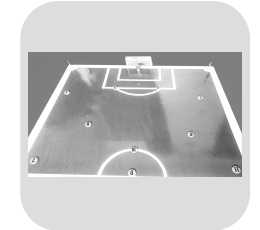
Step board on completely flat surface only. Uneven surface will affect the balance of the game

STEP 5



Set and insert the goal post and corner flags

STEP 6



Set the seeds in any formation you prefer in your half
